1. Purpose of the Competition

1. Eligibility

All children and youth aged from 7 to 18 years in eSwatini equipped with sufficient musical knowledge and skills to master and present the competition piece are eligible to participate in the competition. (Exceptional cases 19 to 20 years old if they are still in High School are also eligible to apply)

2. Admission

After BOTH application form and fee are submitted, a candidate may receive a competition piece. Late and incomplete applications will not be accepted.

3. Dress code

A candidate should be dressed in proper manner at the competition. (ex. shirt, long pants, long skirt, and closed shoes)

4. Accompaniment & Rehearsal

A candidate who enrolls in the Ntjilo's Afterschool Orchestra Education Program may request the accompanist from Ntjilo at no cost. Other candidates may invite their own accompanist or can hire the Ntjilo's accompanist with the fee of E300 (two sessions for 30 min each).

5. Competition Procedure

- A. A candidate should perform without music.
- B. A candidate will be evaluated according to his or her instrument category and performance level.
- C. A judging panel may pause and renew the performance for the sake of ensuring every candidate's best results.
- D. Winners will be announced on the competition date.
- E. The competition results can be made solely upon the judge's professional discretions, and it is final and cannot be reversed.
- F. All inquiries regarding the competition results may be submitted personally and will be handled with respect.

6. Competing order & Tardiness

- A. The competing order will be reasonably determined by Africa Ntjilo Empowerment and announced on the competition date.
- B. A candidate must be present at the venue before the start of the competition. If the candidate is not present at his or her order, he or she is solely responsible for any possible penalty.
